Hopewell Valley has a regional school district overseen by a Board of Education, a nine-member policymaking body elected by the Hopewell Valley community. Based on population, 1 seat on the Board is held by Pennington, 1 seat by Hopewell Borough, and 7 seats by the Township. The Board conducts business at regularly scheduled public meetings, held on the 3rd Monday of every month. Agenda meetings are the 2nd Monday of each month. When a holiday falls on Monday, the meeting is moved to Tuesday. Meetings are held in the Board Meeting Room, Administration Building, 425 South Main Street, Pennington, New Jersey and begin at 7:30 p.m. The public is welcome. Email addresses of Board Members are included on the school district website.
